

## **Proposed CDTA partners to be accorded with priority**

Jurisdictions		Reasons for the need to accord priority to the proposed jurisdiction
1	Australia	<ul> <li>Australia reduced withholding tax on dividends and other distributions.</li> <li>A CDTA is important to provide clarity on rules around permanent establishments and facilitate talent movements between Australia and Hong Kong. This issue manifested in situations such as Covid-19 and in response, the ATO provided specific guidelines to address the Covid-19 situation. Taxpayers would require similar guidance in other non-Covid situations via a CDTA.</li> <li>Welcome any efforts by IRD to ensure:         <ul> <li>A consistent application process for certificates of residence.</li> <li>That treaty partners honor the provisions of the existing treaty network for eligible Hong Kong residents.</li> </ul> </li> <li>One of Hong Kong's top 20 principal trading partners in 2019.</li> </ul>
2	Singapore	<ul> <li>Singapore is important due to the increasing cross-border services and investment.</li> <li>It could provide treaty protection for Hong Kong funds, employees and firms independent of the comprehensive Singapore rules.</li> <li>One of Hong Kong's top 20 principal trading partners in 2019.</li> </ul>
3	USA	<ul> <li>USA reduced withholding tax on dividends and interest.</li> <li>Welcome any efforts by IRD to ensure:         <ul> <li>A consistent application process for certificates of residence.</li> <li>That treaty partners honor the provisions of the existing treaty network for eligible Hong Kong residents.</li> </ul> </li> <li>One of Hong Kong's top 20 principal trading partners in 2019.</li> </ul>
4	Taiwan	One of Hong Kong's top 20 principal trading partners in 2019.
5	Philippines	One of Hong Kong's top 20 principal trading partners in 2019.
6	Other selected African jurisdictions	Enhancing HK as a regional gateway for China's investments and trades with African nations. To make this case, though HK would need to have a number of jurisdictions covered.
